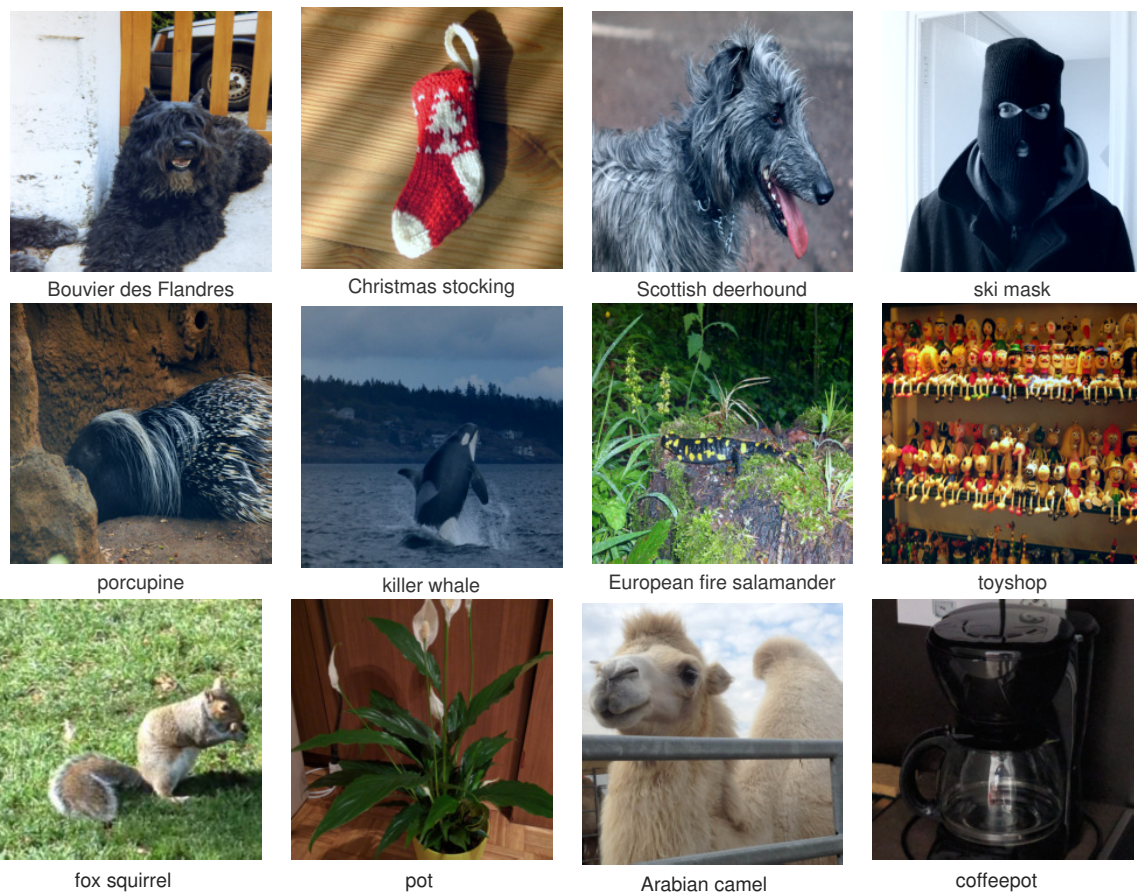


Figure A.1: Original images. The first two rows are randomly chosen images from the validation set, and the last row of images are personal images taken from a mobile phone camera.

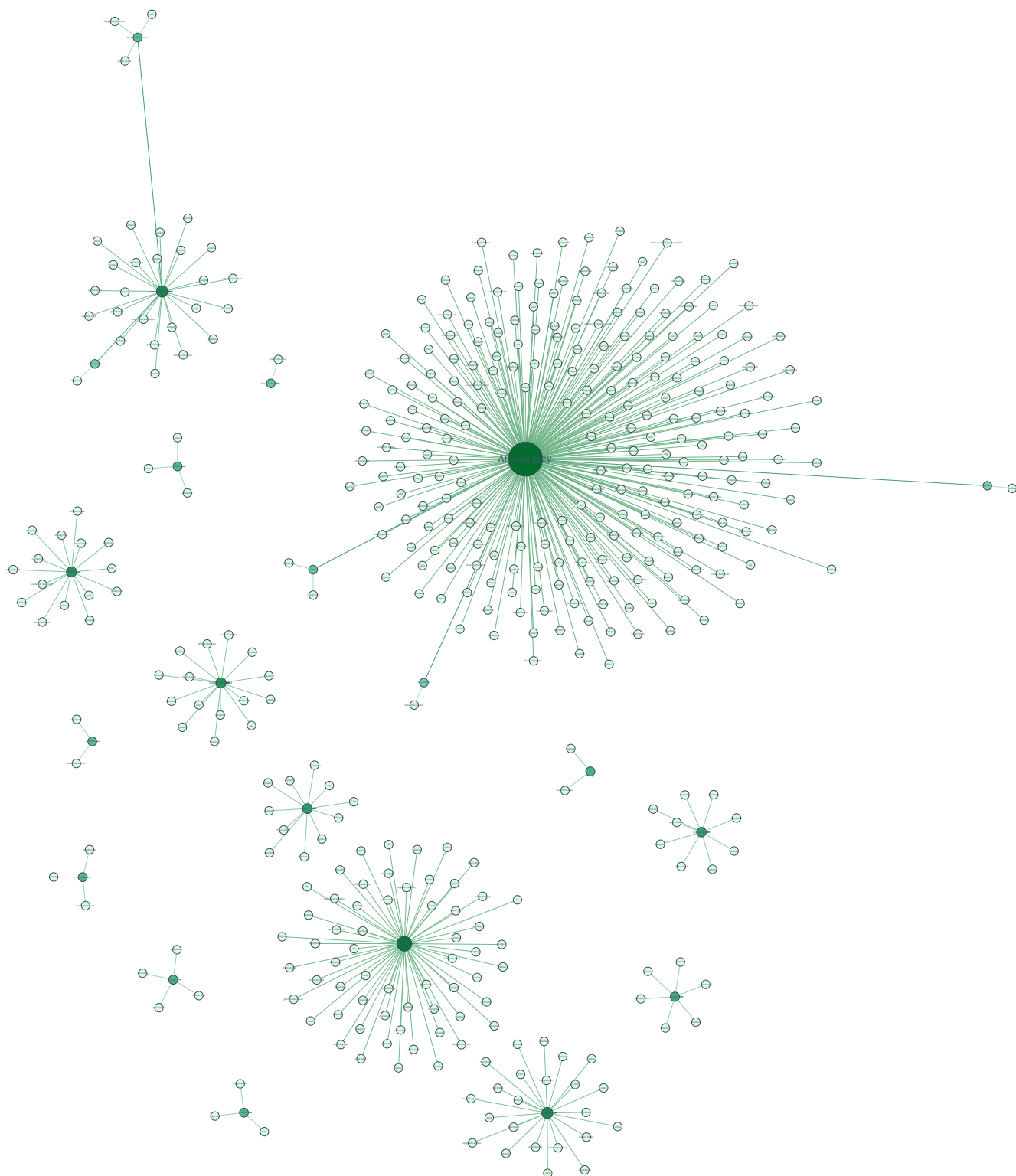
